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What is **PSC**?

PSC is:

Inflammation and destruction of intrahepatic and extrahepatic bile ducts (cholangitis). This leads to segmental scarring and strictures (sclerosing).

There is no known cause; it is an autoimmune disease (primary).



Functions of the Liver

- 1. Regulates metabolism
 - a. Fat
 - b. Carbohydrate (sugar, starch)
 - C. Protein
 - d. Cholesterol
 - e. Vitamins
- 2. Maintains coagulation
- 3. Clears toxins
- 4. Produces enzymes and proteins
- 5. Excretes bile, pigments, and chemicals
- 6. Metabolizes drugs and chemicals



- 4. Anti-pruritic agents





Cholangiocarcinoma complicating PSC






Features of Bacterial Cholangitis











Prognostic Model for PSC

- Useful in PSC only and not generalizable to other liver diseases and only predictive once lab tests become abnormal
- Model:
 - R = .535ln(bili) + .486(Stage on Bx) + .041(age) + .705(spleen)
 - Survival is calculated from R
- Both internally (Mayo) and externally (other centers) validated to predict survival in patients with PSC
